(REVISION OF CH-30 **SUBJECT-VERB AGREEMENT**)

- **EX 1:** FILL IN THE BLANKS WITH THE CORRECT VERB AGREES TO ITS SUBJECT WITH REASON. ONE HAS BEEN DONE FOR YOU.

EXAMPLE: Those two girls \_\_\_\_\_ to eat strawberry ice cream. (want/wants)

REASON: **SUBJECT:** THOSE TWO GIRLS-PLURAL SO **VERB PLURAL-WANT**

### ANSWERS

- Tanveer and Mala **are** going to fair. (is/are) **joined by 'and' so are.**
- She **studies** every night. (study/ studies) **she singular so studies.**
- The audience **was** listening to the concert. (was / were) **audience collective noun so was.**
- My bag, as well as you bag, **was** kept in the class. (was/ were) **joined by as well as so was.**
- The packet of pencils **is** very colourful. (is/are) **packet collective noun so is.**
- The girls in the basketball team **bounce** the ball too high. (bounce/bounces) **girls plural so bounce.**
- You **ride** with me. (ride/rides) **you plural so ride.**
- The women in the pool **swim** (swim/swims) **women plural so swim.**
- The man with the roses **likes** like your brother. (like/ likes) **man singular so likes.**
- Children **do** not like rudeness. (does/do) **children plural so do**
